- **Students will choose a determined number of pictures of Picasso's art from the internet or a text and then select a question from below that applies to each picture.**

Picasso Art Journal: Leading Questions

- **Does anything in this picture appeal to your senses of taste, sound, touch, feel, or taste? Explain.**
- **What puzzles you about this picture? What do you not understand?**
- **Does this picture remind you of something or someone you know? Who or what? Why?**
- **If a movie were made about his picture, what would the movie be about? Give details.**
- **What emotions does this picture make you feel? Sadness? Fear? Happiness? Anger? Frustration? Explain why it makes you feel this way.**
- **If this picture had background music, what song would you choose to be playing? How does it represent the picture?**
- **Poetry expresses emotions with words; art expresses emotions with pictures. Look closely at this picture. If it could talk, what would it say? Write a short poem about the picture.**
- **If a story were written about this picture, what would its title be? Why?**
- **Does this picture remind you of anything that has happened in your life? What?**
- **If this picture were teaching you a lesson, what would you learn from it?**
- **If you were to write a story about this picture, the first line would be, "Once upon a time... (Finish it with details).**
- **If you could give this picture to someone you love, who would you give it to? Why would they like it?**

- **Imagine that this picture can talk. What does it say to you?**
- **What do you not like about this picture? How does it make you feel? How would you change it?**
- **You are the creator of a new video game. This picture is the poster that advertises your video game. Describe the video game.**
- **Does this picture remind you of a Fairy Tale? Which one and why?**
